This month, crack open a diverse range of beer styles produced by talented Australian craft breweries off the beaten track.



BAD SHEPHERD HAZELNUT BROWN

- BROWN ALE
- ABV: 5.6%
- CHELTENHAM, VIC

A toasty and malty ale loaded with the rich nuttiness of roasted hazelnuts. Brewed with real hazelnuts, vanilla and a splash of Frangelico. Smooth and nutty with a dry clean finish.



FOGHORN NEWY PALE ALE

- PALE ALE
- ABV: 4.5%
- NEWCASTLE, NSW

Fresh, aromatic hop driven pale ale. Hops are added as late as possible in the brewing process, which maxes out the fruity hop flavour and aroma without maxing out the bitterness.



IRON HOUSE RETURN OF THE MACK

- HAZY ALE
- ABV: 4.4%
- FOUR MILE CK, TAS

Return of the Mack is a fruity, easy drinking hazy ale with a fresh citrus and slight farmhouse taste. Ultra refreshing you'll detect just a hint of bitterness at the end.



MINISTRY OF BEER MOSAIC BERLINER WEISSE

- BERLINER WEISSE
- ABV: 3.5%
- BAROSSA VALLEY, SA

From the outskirts of the Barossa Valley comes a unique kettle sour. Pilsner and wheat malt provide a nice light backing for the Mosaic hops, which add a nice passionfruit note.

QUAKERS HAT RED RYE IPA

- RYE IPA
- ABV: 6.0%
- MANLY VALE NSW

Dark, malty brew coupled with big hop flavours reminiscent of blackberry and tropical fruits. The rye kicks up some spicy notes which meld nicely with the malt backbone and fruity hop profile.



RECKLESS SMALL BATCH HAZY XPA

- HAZY XPA
- ABV: 4.2%
- FIVE DOCK, NSW

Big juicy tropical hops dominate but this is a hazy with a difference. With an alcohol content of 4.2% and full of Galaxy and Azacca hops, this brew is ultra sessionable.



SEA LEGS BREWING DR SWIFT'S GOLDEN ALE

- GOLDEN ALE
- ABV: 4.0%
- BRISBANE, QLD

Another session ale that impressed our team. Pouring a pleasing golden colour, this refreshing ale has a particularly pleasant hop character and endless drinkability.



TEMPLE BREWING RICE XPA

- XPA
- ABV: 5.1%
- BRUNSWICK, VIC

This XPA is brewed with rice and is unsparingly dry-hopped. Expect something tropical, crisp and crushable. A distinctive brew from the talented folks at Temple. Give it a whirl!
